**Luke 7: 1-10**

After Jesus had finished all his sayings in the hearing of the people, he entered Capernaum. A centurion there had a slave whom he valued highly, and who was ill and close to death. When he heard about Jesus, he sent some Jewish elders to him, asking him to come and heal his slave.

When they came to Jesus, they appealed to him earnestly, saying, "He is worthy of having you do this for him, for he loves our people, and it is he who built our synagogue for us." And Jesus went with them, but when he was not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to say to him, "Lord, do not trouble yourself, for I am not worthy to have you come under my roof; therefore I did not presume to come to you. But only speak the word, and let my servant be healed. For I also am a man set under authority, with soldiers under me; and I say to one, 'Go,' and he goes, and to another, 'Come,' and he comes, and to my slave, 'Do this,' and the slave does it."

When Jesus heard this he was amazed at him, and turning to the crowd that followed him, he said, "I tell you, not even in Israel have I found such faith." When those who had been sent returned to the house, they found the slave in good health.

#### Life. Faith. Meaning.

Alpha is a series of interactive sessions that freely explore the basics of the Christian faith. Each session begins with a meal, followed by a talk that considers a different question around faith and is designed to create conversation. There is plenty of opportunity to discuss, ask questions and share view points in a small group. Alpha runs globally, with more than 29 million people having taken part.

Denmead Alpha is open for everyone: whether you're new to the Christian faith, been attending church a long time, wanting to cover the basics of the Christian faith or just exploring. There is no pressure, no follow-up and no charge.

This Autumn we are working in partnership with Denmead Baptist Church to host this course. The first session begins on **Wednesday 5th September at 7-9.30pm at All Saints in the Heath Room**.
