Monday 26th August - Bank Holiday

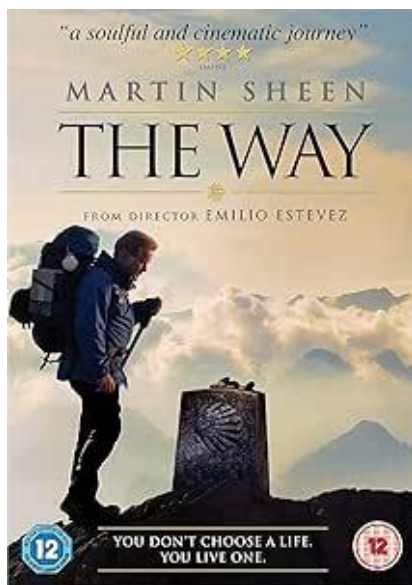
The parish office will be closed for the Bank Holiday.

We welcome our friends from Sacred Heart Catholic church as they celebrate Mass here at All Saints. All are welcome to attend this service.

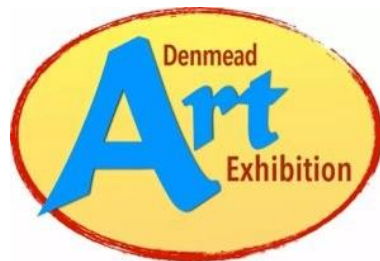

It would be useful to read the book in preparation for each Sunday. (In the Sunday service we will only use a selection from each book – not the whole thing!) Each minor prophet is short in length and will only take 5-20 mins to read. We've included the page numbers as found in the Bible we use in church.

29th Sept	Zephaniah: Hope Remains (pgs. 889-892)
06th October	Harvest Celebration

20th October	Zechariah: Grace and Forgiveness (pgs. 894-902)
27th October	Malachi: A Better Day is Coming! (pgs. 903-905)
