It would be useful to read the book in preparation for each Sunday. (In the Sunday service we will only use a selection from each book – not the whole thing!)



Each minor prophet is short in length and will only take 5-20 mins to read. We've included the page numbers as found in the Bible we use in church.

13th October Haggai: Renew the Vision (pgs. 892-893)

20th October Zechariah: Grace and Forgiveness (pgs. 894-902)27th October Malachi: A Better Day is Coming! (pgs. 903-905)
