Sunday 13th April - 6th Sunday of Lent – Palm Sunday

This Sunday the readings are **Psalm 104: 14-22** (pages 157-160 in The Whole Easter Story) **Deuteronomy 22: 6-7** (pages 168-170 in The Whole Easter Story) and **Luke 19: 28-40** (Palm Sunday Story)

At **8am** we gather for a **traditional BCP Holy Communion Service**. Canon David Lindsay will preside and preach.

At **10am** we gather for our **Together service**. This service is for all ages as we worship, learn, and grow together. The service will be led by Revd. Emma, Peter Mitchell, our Licensed Minister (Reader) and team. Please stay after the service for refreshments served and games the church hall.
