ear Friends,

Last month Revd. Buffy introduced us to Thy Kingdom Come (TKC). This is a global, ecumenical prayer movement that invites Christians around the world to pray for more people to come to know Jesus. It began in 2016, and over the last 10 years has grown into a huge movement which unites more than a million Christians in prayer – all praying that God's reign would be fully realized on earth – through justice, peace, and transformed lives. Thy Kingdom Come begins on Thursday 29th

May (Ascension Day) until Sunday 8th June (Pentecost).

Once again, this year Thy Kingdom Come urges us to pray for five people; family, friends, neighbours, colleagues — that each person will encounter Jesus in their life and respond 'yes' to God's call. During TKC you might like to join us for Morning Prayer (each weekday at 8.30am in our chapel) we'll be using TKC liturgy that enables us to cry out, 'Thy Kingdom Come' and space to name our five people.

Then this year, to mark the 10th anniversary of Thy Kingdom Come, Portsmouth Diocese is encouraging each deanery to host a day of prayer and pilgrimage.

Denmead is part of Havant Deanery, and our prayer walk will be on

Wednesday 4th June: it will begin at 9am at St Peter's Church on Hayling Island, and finish at All Saints, Catherington at 5pm. In the evening, we will gather at All Saints, Denmead for an Evening Prayer Celebration at 7pm.

Following this letter, you will find all the information showing the route through our deanery, along with times when we'll be stopping to pause and pray at churches along the way. Please can I encourage



you to come to as much or as little as the walk as you are able to. If you're not able to walk, you are very welcome to come to one of the stopping points and share in prayer and a coffee! I will be joining the whole walk, and it would be wonderful to see some 'Denmeadians' for all or part of the journey.



And finally, there is also a focus on The Lord's Prayer. The Lord's Prayer is the prayer that Jesus taught his disciples, when they asked him how they should pray. This final line is a reminder that God's Kingdom, power, and glory remain steadfast. Hardships will come and go, but God's unfailing love remains the same yesterday, today, and always.

If you would like to explore this prayer in more detail, please come and pick up a FREE copy of this short devotional booklet written by the Archbishop of York, Stephen Cotterell, available in our welcome area in church.

So can I urge you – make the most of TKC – pray for five people, pray for our community and parish, and pray for our deanery and diocese – that God's Kingdom would come – and His will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.

#### **Unveiling of George Cross plaque**

As part of the recent VE Day remembrance, the Denmead Village Association (DVA) unveiled a George Cross plaque in honour of Charles Tandy-Green for his selfless act of bravery.



The DVA were joined by Denmead War Memorial Hall Committee



Chairman, Cathy Caine, Hampshire County Councillor Patricia Stallard and Revd. Buffy Langdown.

During the unveiling ceremony, DVA committee member Daniel Stallard, who was entrusted by the DVA to research Charles Tandy-Green and have the plaque made, said:

"Thank you for joining us today to mark this momentous occasion as we unveil this plaque dedicated to the memory and bravery of Charles Tandy-Green. This plaque stands not only as a symbol of remembrance but as a testament to the enduring legacy of all

individuals who shaped our community and its history.

I am deeply honoured to have been given the opportunity to research the life of Charles Tandy Green — a man whose story reflects the courage, resilience, and commitment to serve his community. It was on this very day, the 8th May 1934, that Charles Tandy-Green displayed a selfless act of bravery by thwarting the


assassination attempt on Governor Sir John Anderson by wrestling a gunman to the ground. By remembering these efforts, our community's past remains alive & meaningful for generations to come.

I would also like to extend great thanks to the Denmead War Memorial Hall for providing the perfect home for this plaque. #### Our ethos is Fun, Friendship, Learning and Laughter.



## HAMPSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL Updates on M27, Recycling & Support

#### M27 Junction 10 Scheme Update

Lane Reductions: The number of lanes on the motorway has been reduced from four to three, with a 50mph speed limit in place until the scheme's completion in late 2026.

Guide Slab Formation: A complex operation involving 1,000m³ of concrete, cast in three phases during February and March, will ensure the underpass can slide accurately into its final position.

Construction Notice: Over the next few months, work on the "box" next to and north of the motorway will become more noticeable, with the base, walls and roof being created in preparation for the sliding of the concrete box into position beneath the motorway at Christmas.

Christmas 2025 Closure: The new underpass will be installed beneath the M27 between Junctions 9 and 11 over Christmas and New Year, requiring a full closure of the M27 during the school holidays when traffic volumes are lower. Closure dates and travel advice will be provided.

Forthcoming Night Works: Programmed for summer 2025, the A32 Junction with the western end of Pook Lane will be closed but access to Pook Lane from M27 Junction 11 and the eastern end will be maintained. The new A32 Broadway roundabout is currently being built, leading to changes in traffic management measures on the A32 north of the M27.

#### Green light to boost recycling rates

Plans to construct a new, state of the art recycling facility for Hampshire, have been given the go-ahead enabling residents to recycle a wider range of household materials at the kerbside.

Based in Eastleigh, the new Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) is expected to be up and running by the end of 2027 and will support all households across Hampshire to recycle:

- a wider range of plastics including pots, tubs, trays, cartons and soft plastic film

Currently a tiny proportion of waste is sent to landfill in Hampshire, with the bulk either recycled or incinerated. Any waste diverted from incineration is not only better for the environment creating less carbon, but also increases the recycling rate, costs less to dispose of and has a second, third or fourth life as a new product. Importantly, it also helps maximise return for local taxpayers. The proposal to build a new £50.5 million MRF has been developed in conjunction with Hampshire's neighbouring waste disposal partners, Portsmouth City Council and Southampton City Council, who will jointly fund the project ensuring a consistent service across the region.

The new approach being taken aligns with Government's Simpler Recycling guidance on residential kerbside recycling – separating dry materials from other waste to reduce contamination – which occurs when dry recyclable material, such as card, is unable to be recycled if it gets wet or stained with food residue or mixed with glass. Managing waste in this way will minimise the cost of sorting 'contaminated' materials (currently around £2 million per year) and ensure the recyclable materials, carefully sorted by Hampshire residents, can be put to best possible use.

#### Deadline for School Transport - SEND

School Transport is available to eligible children from the school term after their fifth birthday up to and including Year 11. With the end of the academic year fast approaching, HCC is reminding local families of the upcoming application deadlines:

For children with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) – 30th June. Applications received after the relevant deadline will be treated as late applications and will only be reviewed after all on-time applications have been processed. For eligible families who apply late, transport will not be in place for September 2025 and may not be available before December 2025. Before applying for School Transport, families are strongly encouraged to check the eligibility criteria - https://www.hants.gov.uk/educationandlearning/schooltransport/parent-carer/eligibility

Families with children who already receive School Transport do not need to do anything unless their circumstances have changed, for example, if they have

#### Post-16 Transport

For most families, transport assistance stops at the end of Year 11. Families are asked to explore alternative transport arrangements for their child's post-16 education or training, even if their child will continue to attend the same setting. A discretionary Post-16 Transport service is available in certain circumstances, for young people with SEND who are unable to access their further education or training without transport assistance from the Council. Applications are only approved where there is clear evidence that nobody else in the young person's household is able to transport them.

As a discretionary service, parents are required to pay a partial financial contribution towards the costs of transport. To be considered for this service for the 2025/26 academic year, families must apply by 30th June 2025. For eligible families who apply after this deadline, transport will not be in place for September 2025 and may not be available before January 2026.


